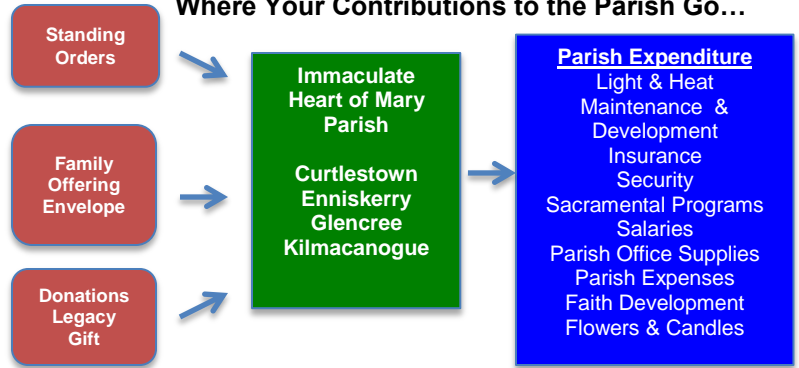

Dear Parishioner.

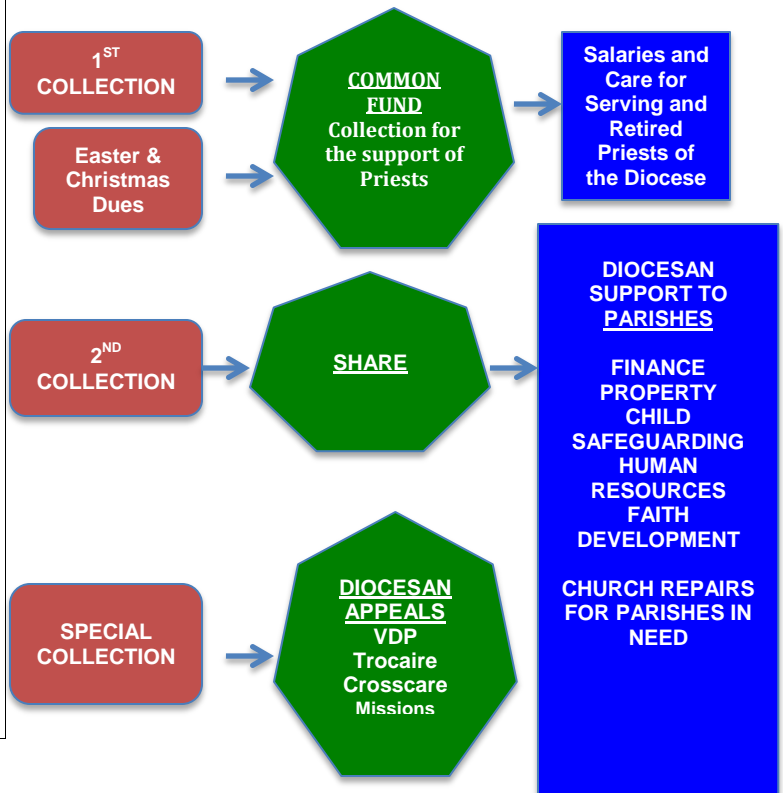
This is an appeal to you from the Parish for support in the running of your local church and all the churches of our Parish.
