It's that time of year again when the parish begins its preparation for the Sacraments of First Penance and First Eucharist. Much of the preparation is covered very well by our wonderful teachers, but the home and parish play a vital role in helping our children to get to know Jesus so that the Sacraments have full meaning for them.

We understand that some parents may not wish their children to receive the Sacraments, but for those who do, we have an initial meeting with all parents and guardians.

This will take place for all three schools: Enniskerry, Kilmacanogue and Curtlestown on **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at 7:30pm**. The venue for the meeting this year is the **St. Mary's Church Enniskerry**. If possible please car pool as parking is limited.

Please note that you need only bring a Baptismal certificate if your son/daughter were **not** baptised in one of the following parishes: Holy Redeemer Bray, Queen of Peace Bray, St Peters Little Bray, St Fergals Ballywaltrim or Any of the Three churches in Enniskerry St Mary's, Kilmacanogue and Curtlestown.

**This needs to be presented at the meeting.**

There is also small administration fee of 30 Euro, which should be given on the night of the meeting please. Please have both of the above in an envelope with the child's name and school clearly marked on it.

**It is essential that you attend this meeting** if you wish your son/daughter to proceed to First Holy Communion.
