The Crucifix is of significant historical Parish heritage, and it will be presented to the Parish by Rory Golden at 11:00 am Mass in St. Marys Church today to commemorate the 160th. Anniversary of the Church. It will be wall mounted near the Sanctuary area.

Dear parishioners

Today I make a financial appeal. We have delivered this appeal to homes over the last few weeks with the encouragement to look at your donations to the parish. 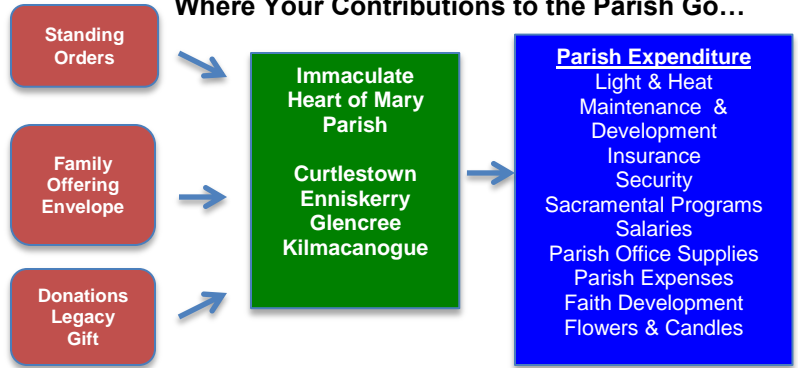
