Words of Welcome

Celebrant: We are here today to celebrate a special occasion, the First Holy Communion of these wonderful children. The children will be sharing the Bread of Life for the first time. Through His life, death and resurrection, Jesus is and always will be present in a special way in the lives of these children who have waited a long time to make their First Holy Communion.

Penitential Rite

Celebrant: The children did not have an opportunity earlier this year to make their First Confession which is also called the Sacrament of Reconciliation and so we will now celebrate this sacrament together as one big family, the family of God.

Let us bow our heads in silence and remember a time when we did not show love to one another, or to our family or to our friends. Did we make bad choices like Zacchaeus the tax collector and were we mean to those around us?

(a moment of silence)

Celebrant: Children, let us now say together your special prayer asking God our Father for forgiveness.

Children: O my God, help me to remember the times when I didn't live as Jesus asked me to. Help me to be sorry and to try again.

All: Amen

Celebrant: Let us hear the children offer up their own special Act of Sorrow.

Children: O my God, I thank you for loving me. I'm sorry for all my sins, for not loving others and not loving you. Help me to live like Jesus and not sin again.

All: Amen

Prayer of Absolution

Celebrant: And my brothers and sisters as adults, let us acknowledge our sins, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries as we all pray

All: I confess to almighty God
and to you, my brothers and sisters,
that I have greatly sinned
in my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done
and in what I have failed to do,
(All strike their chest three times)
through my fault, through my fault,
through my most grievous fault;
therefore, I asked blessed Mary ever-Virgin,
all the Angels and Saints,
and you, my brothers and sisters,
to pray for me to the Lord our God. Amen

Celebrant: Let us remember the times when we haven't lived like Jesus, times when the connection between ourselves and others was broken or weakened, times when we strayed from God's love.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus, you have come to show us how to love. You have shown us how to share our lives with others. Lord, have mercy.

All: Lord, have mercy.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus, you forgive us when we are being selfish and think only of ourselves. We know that you are with us and that you forgive us today. We know that you will be with us tomorrow. Christ, have mercy.

All: Christ, have mercy.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus, you are the Good Shepherd who searches for us when we are lost. You look after all people everywhere.

Lord, have mercy. All: Lord, have mercy

Celebrant: May Almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins and bring us to everlasting life.

All: Amen.

Celebrant: And children, now that you have been forgiven, please say your special prayer after forgiveness.

Children: O my God, thank you for forgiving me. Help me to love others. Help me to live as Jesus asked me to.

All: Amen

Celebrant: We have now completed the Penitential Rite which is the Forgiveness part of our special First Holy Communion Mass.

Let us continue on with the Mass as we pray for these children who are about to make their first Holy Communion.

Celebrant: God our Father, you are indeed our Father. You watch over us with gentle care. Today, we joyfully present these children for their First Holy Communion. We pray that in the years ahead they may often return to be nourished and fed at the altar. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen



LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST



Eucharistic Prayer for Children

Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

All: And with your spirit.

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts.

All: We lift them up to the Lord.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God.

All: It is right and just.

Celebrant: God our Father, you have brought us here together so that we can give you thanks and praise for all the wonderful things you have done.

We thank you for all that is beautiful in the world and for the happiness you have given us. We praise you for daylight and for your word which lights up our minds. We praise you for the earth, and for all the people who live on it, and for our life which comes from you. We know that you are good. You love us and do great things for us.

Father, you are always thinking about your people, you never forget us. You sent your Son, Jesus, who gave his life for us and who came to save us. He cured the sick people; He cared for those who were poor and wept with those who were sad. He forgave sinners and taught us to forgive each other. He loved everyone and showed us how to be kind.

He took children in his arms and blessed them. God Our Father, all over the world your people praise you. So now we pray with the whole Church: with Francis our Pope and Dermot Farrell our Archbishop. In heaven, the Blessed Virgin Mary, the apostles and all the saints always sing your praise. Now, we join with them and with the angels to adore you as we say:

All: Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, God of hosts,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.

Celebrant: God Our Father, you are most holy and we want to show you that we are grateful. We bring you bread and wine and ask you to send your Holy Spirit to make these gifts the + Body and Blood of Jesus your Son. Then we can offer to you what you have given to us.

On the night before he died, Jesus was having supper with his apostles. He took bread from the table. He gave you thanks and praise.

Then he broke the bread, gave it to his friends and said:

TAKE THIS ALL OF YOU, AND EAT THIS: FOR THIS IS MY BODY WHICH WILL BE GIVEN UP FOR YOU.

When supper was ended, Jesus took the cup that was filled with wine. He thanked you, gave it to his friends and said:

TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND DRINK FROM IT:
THIS IS THE CHALICE OF MY BLOOD, THE BLOOD OF THE
NEW AND ETERNAL CHALICE WHICH WILL BE POURED
OUT FOR YOU AND FOR MANY FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF
SINS.

Then he said: **DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME.**

We do now what Jesus told us to do. We remember his death and resurrection and we offer You, Father, the bread that gives us life and the cup that saves us. Jesus brings us to you: welcome us as you welcome him.

Celebrant: Let us proclaim the Mystery of Faith.

All: Christ has died alleluia, Christ is risen alleluia, Christ will come again alleluia

Celebrant: Father, because you love us, you invite us to come to your table. Fill us with the joy of the Holy Spirit as we receive the body and blood of your Son. Lord, you never forget any of your children. We ask you to take care of those we love, especially those for whom we now pray. We pray also, for those we have loved who have died and gone before us.

Remember everyone who is suffering from pain or sorrow. Remember Christians everywhere and all other people in the world. We are filled with wonder and praise when we see what you do for us through Jesus Christ your Son and so we say:

Through him,

And with him
And in him,
O God Almighty Father,
In the unity of the Holy Spirit,
All glory and honour is yours,
Forever and ever.

All: Amen.

COMMUNION RITE

Celebrant: Let us pray with confidence to the Father in the words Jesus taught us as I invite the children to stand in their places and do the actions as we say:

All: Our Father, who art in heaven. Hallowed be thy name.

Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.

Celebrant: Deliver us Lord from every evil and grant us peace in our day. In your mercy keep us free from sin and protect us from all anxiety as we wait in joyful hope for the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

All: For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and forever.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus Christ, you said to your apostles: I leave you peace, my peace I give you. Look not on our sins but on the faith of your church and grant us the peace and unity of your kingdom where you live forever and ever.

All: Amen.

Celebrant: The peace of the Lord be with you always.

All: And with your spirit.

Celebrant: Let us offer one another the Sign of Peace with a wave or a smile

All: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us.

Children: Lord Jesus, come to me.




