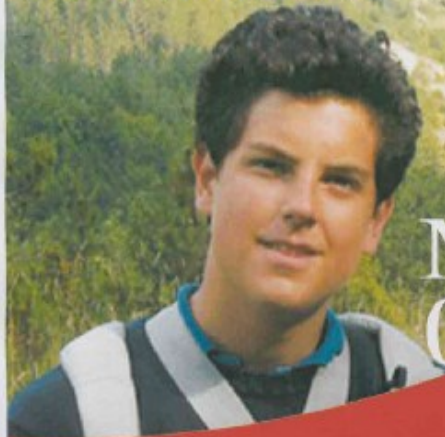

Parishes will be aware from a letter circulated to all last April that the Annual Diocesan Pilgrimage will be taking place in Lourdes this year from 7th to 12th September. However, sadly, on medical advice, it was decided that there would not be a special section for sick pilgrims staying at the Accueil in Lourdes.

The pilgrimage is being managed by Joe Walsh Tours as was previously stated from their new office in Harcourt Street (Phone: 01 241 0800) and to date around 600 pilgrims have booked places. A good number of parish groups have also booked including a few new parish groups which is always nice to see.

There are still a number of places available and last minute bookings can still be made by groups or individuals by contacting the Joe Walsh Tours Office. More information is also on their website - www.joewalstours.ie

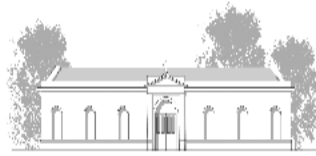
