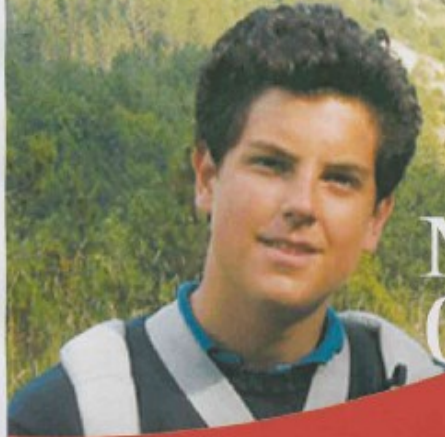

A good number of parish groups have also booked including a few new parish groups which is always nice to see.

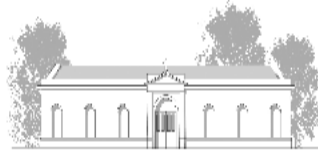
