Send us out with love to build up Hope.

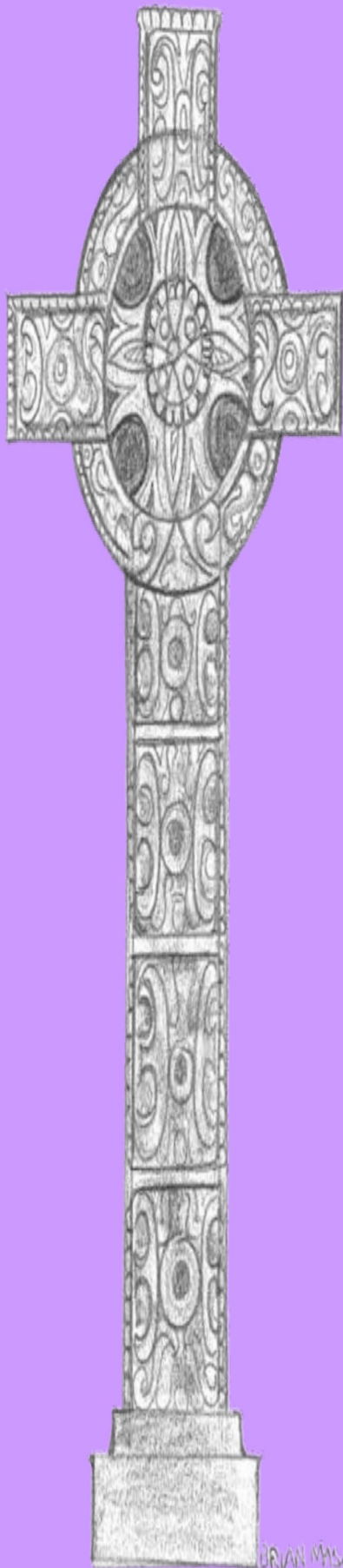
Enniskerry Welcomes News Update
